

# CIRCULAR KNITTING

## VIDEO NOTES

### PART 1 CIRCULAR KNITTING

- Cut out the rectangle from the box
- Mark 6 points with 5cm gaps on the box
- Total 30cm
- At 30cm create a dotted line
- Roll the card into a cylinder
- Pinch together
- Tape from outside to inside to create a clean circle
- Both sides
- Mark 4cm on lollipop stick
- Repeat so you have 6 lollipop sticks
- Line up your lollipop stick with the 5cm marks around your cylinder.
- Use sticky tape to secure
- Double check lollipop sticks are secure!
- Make a loop from the inside of the cylinder, around the stick and back to the inside. Continue until you have completed the circle.
- Repeat to create 2 loops on each stick
- Hold wool so it doesn't unravel
- Take the bottom loop and carefully guide it over the top loop
- Tug tail gently to secure
- Push the remaining loop down

- Repeat
- Loop gently, not tightly!
- See how stretchy your knitting is!
- Continue knitting until you have about 5cm tail
- (knit longer if you like!)
- Snip your wool
- Take the loop it connects to off the stick Carefully!!!!
- Thread through.
- Pull to secure.
- Repeat carefully removing loop and threading through.
- Tie in a secure knot.
- Go to other end and find the middle.
- Ease your hand into the knitted tube.
- What else fits inside?!...

### PART TWO – HOT AIR BALLOON

- Next you will need an egg box, scissors, paper clips, wool and sticky tape
- Cut out 1 section
- Squeeze together and tape
- Wiggle paper clip through.
- Secure the knit to the balloon by wrapping and knotting
- Thread through paper clips and make a knot
- Tie basket to hot air balloon.
